



MoA WG Charter

- Resistance management strategies require a rigorous classification of insecticides based on parameters that reflect the likelihood of common resistance mechanisms between groups. Because mode of action is the most fundamental property of an insecticide family, the Mode of Action Working Group is charged with developing and maintaining this classification and materials for educating about the classification and insecticide mode of action. The classification is to be based on the best available information about the target site, but may incorporate any additional information that helps IRAC better achieve its mission of developing sound resistance management strategies.
